Judging Criteria for Arts & Sciences Champion Competitions

- Use this set of criteria when judging A & S entries
- More than one entrant can receive full marks
- Each contestant will receive at least one point for his or her entry

Broad Categories – Not all descriptors will apply. Try to 'average out' the overall mark based upon how well the entry fits in to the category(s).

5 Excellent

- ◆ Excellent documentation relating to materials and execution of the piece. Well researched and clear. This must also include any adjustments that were made (with a reasonable explanation for the changes).
- ◆ Excellent Execution Well made or well presented following the guidelines set by their documentation.

A more complex project attempted and completed with a high degree of competence.

4 Very Good

- ◆ Good documentation Information about how the entry was made according to researched sources however, this may be more vague than in Category 5.
- ♦ Well executed Although flaws might be evident they are not significant and/or the entry is not in keeping with its documentation.

A simple project, completed to a high standard, or a complex project exhibiting some of the above flaws.

3 Reasonable

- ◆ **Some documentation** Some evidence that the piece and materials/execution are period.
- ♦ **Reasonable execution** Several flaws there may be one of two semi serious ones.

2 Fair

- ◆ **Little or no documentation** but some effort made towards making the entry 'period'.
- ♦ **Poor execution** Several large flaws

- **Much to Improve**
- No documentation piece is only vaguely period.
 Execution weak Flaws dominate piece.
