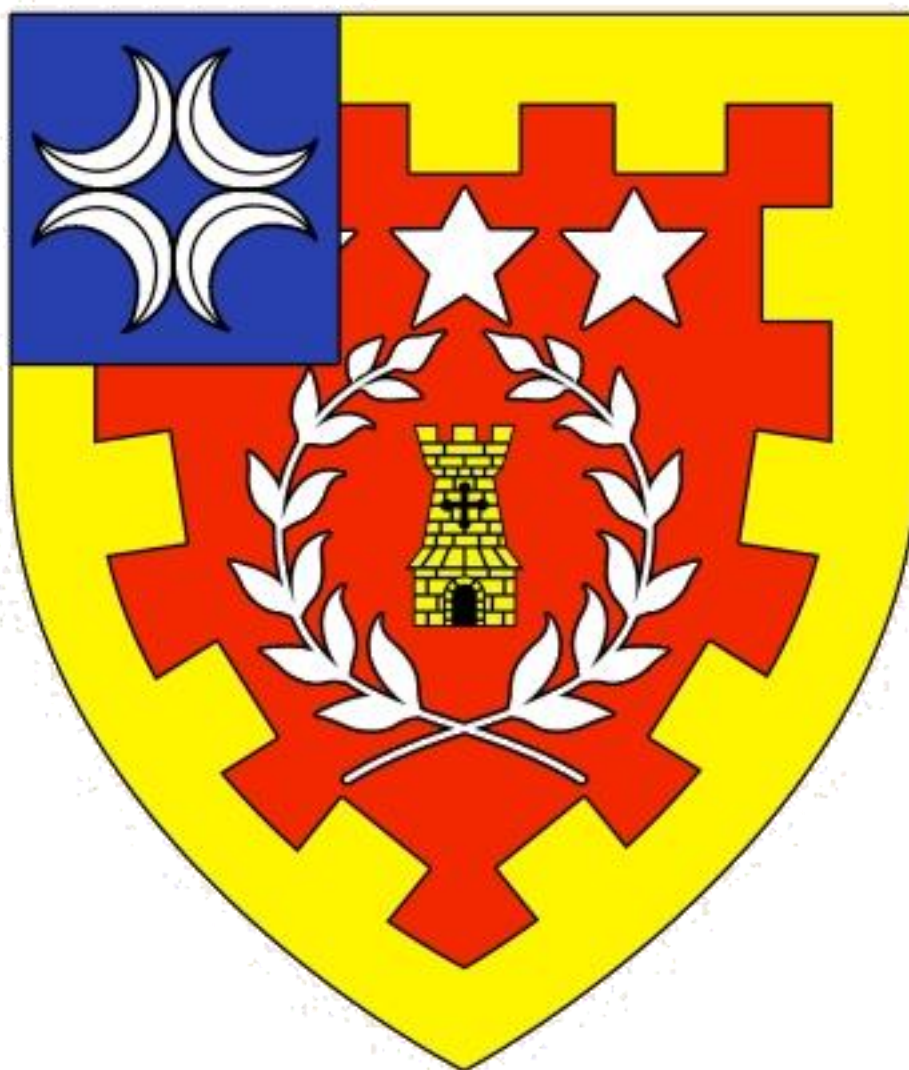

Nominations will be sent to the Crown no later
than 4 October.

candidates prior to announcing the successors at
November Crown - 7 November.

During the nomination period nominees are to
discuss with the incumbent Baron and Baroness
their roles, plans and fitness for office. Nominees
may withdraw at any time within this period. All
nominees must provide a letter of intent
describing themselves and giving a brief history of
their time in the SCA and their plans should they
be selected to take office as Baron and Baroness,
which will be published to the Barony.

NB: Nominees must be paid members of the
Society when they take office. Nominees do not
have to be resident within the boundaries of the
Barony so long as they can show that they can
fulfil the duties of the office and can demonstrate
a history of active participation within the group.
