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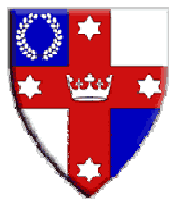
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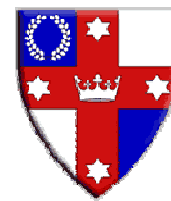

MEETING OPENED: 7:33pm

MINUTES FROM LAST MEETING: Moved to accept by Geoffrey, seconded by Amalie, passed.

OFFICER REPORTS

BARON AND BARONESS (Christopher and Clare): Correspondence In: CC'd Officer Reports: Captain of Archers, Chatelaine and Chronicler. Lord Oswyn: CC'd BA Budget; Baronial Library; names of helpful people. Sir Tycho: BA Heavy Tourney format. BA Letters of Intent: various. Mistress Isabel: various BA items. Lady Amalie: Baronial Library. Lord Raffe: Showbiz evacuation. Correspondence Out: Lord Oswyn: Baronial Library. Lady Amalie: Baronial Library. Mistress Isabel: various BA items. Sir Tycho: BA Heavy Tourney format. Lord Raffe: Showbiz evacuation. Chronicler: FTT column. Attended: Baronial Anniversary (Our thanks to the Steward and her team of tireless helpers ... Huzzah!). Invested newest Baronial Champions.

SENESCHAL (Oswyn): Correspondence with: the Baronial herald, TEs regarding letters of intent and handovers at BA, HE Eleanora, HE Antonia, the Kingdom Webwright regarding the appointment of a new baronial Webwright. Correspondence with the KS regarding correspondence with the Kingdom Webwright. Correspondence with HRM regarding tickets and attendance at BA. Correspondence with HEs regarding helpful people in the barony post-quake, with THL Amalie regarding the baronial library,

with Raffe regarding removal of baronial property from Showbiz, with Westpac regarding having the new Reeve added as a signatory to the baronial cheque accounts with the Reeve regarding event reports and with the purpose of cheques written. Have also received correspondence from the CCC, asking for payment for the past two months' use of the practice hall. Have pointed out we were told it was not useable until further notice in February. Correspondence with the heavy marshal and two parties regarding applications for the marshallate. The current marshal's warrant expired at BA. HE Eleanora has been confirmed by the KW as Baronial webwright, barring substantial objection from the populace. The commentary period shall be up on the 29th of April. Lugged a bit of stuff out of the trailer into showbiz, and away for the BA cooking. Did a teeny bit of heralding at BA, and various menial tasks. A vote of thanks to our webwright and heavy marshal wot are stepping down.

REEVE (Richard): No report this month.

HERALD (Maximilian): Shouted a Tourney, Presided over a couple of courts. Did nothing at all to do with book heraldry or blazoning. Nothing else to report.

ARTS AND SCIENCES (Amalie): Attended BA, and ran the championship with last year's champion, Elisabetta. Many thanks to the judges and to all the entrants. The new champion is Ginevra. Bjorn ran a bonework class on Sunday, which I was unable to attend. There is still no access to the hall, so Stuff Night was held at Sigurd and Eleanora's place. The Baronial Library is now housed with Raffe and Melisande.

CHATELAINE (Chunegund): Attended Baronial Anniversary. Received back all garb from Canterbury Faire, loaned 1 set to returning newcomers for BA. Met possible newcomer at a party – we shall see what happens at Yule/next event. Contact with Seneschal re CINCH

database details. Ordered Known World Handbook for Barony through HE Eleanora, yet to hear from her re money. Plan for coming month: re-gather quotes on iron on transfer paper as some of my previous quotes no longer apply.

CHRONICLER (Elisabetta): FTT put on the website and send to subscribers 1 April. Correspondence with event stewards, B&B and Seneschal. Due date for May edition 22 April at 5pm. Will be looking for a replacement - two month advertising period from now on.

QUARTERMASTER (Angus): No report this month.

CONSTABLE (Agnes): Attended Baronial Anniversary and law and order was maintained. Some lost property was collected, as yet to be advertised. That is all.

CAPTAIN OF ARCHERS (Geoffrey): Confirmed our access to Kirkwood with the school; they're still happy to let us use the field, but did ask to make sure that we don't leave arrows behind. Some other group had been on the field between the quake and us returning, and the school doesn't want arrows left on the field the students are using. Had a couple of practises - still getting 5 or 6 people along, although the weather will be a problem soon. Hoping to have some workshops over the winter, again. Attended BA, had nothing official to do.

RAPIER (Emilio): Tourney held at BA had 9 fighters. Thanks to Martuccio for running this tournament as the previous champion, and congrats to him for winning this year's tourney. There have been no practices of late, but interest seems to be increasing, so can maybe start these back up again.

LISTS (Emilio): Thanks to Max and Iuliana for running the lists at BA. Am currently working with Max to devise a Round Robin Cheat Sheet. Want to make a list tree for the Barony, based on the success of the one used at CF.

MARSHAL (Raffe): Good numbers to fighter practice in anticipation of BA. Mid-week practice now finished due to daylight savings finishing; grateful thanks for Sir Tycho for organising these.

Quarterly report forwarded to Kingdom Marshal, including all CF casualties, war and tourney info, etc. Returned Baronial trailer to Showbiz lockup (all clear after earthquake) and unloaded it with assistance from the BA steward and Seneschal in preparation of gear needed out on site for BA. BA tournament held with 9 fighters taking the field. The tourney was a close quarter affair (being held in an 8ft² Eric) with some new rules on blows received and lives lost. A very enjoyable afternoon's fighting. Assisted Quartermaster in preparation for BA and items needed. Collected and returned the Baronial trailer to Rimu Park site/Showbiz. Travelled up to CF site to repair the fort and put it away. Also took a stock take of the container's contents for the Constable to follow up any action on payment for storage. Retrieved the Baronial tables and delivered to Quartermaster for BA. Worked with Darius to collect two donated turboprop ovens and relocated them to Showbiz storage facility. New plugs required for both, but will be a great asset in future for venues that have limited cooking facilities. Communicated with Seneschal about upcoming Marshal changeover.

CANTERBURY FAIRE (Raffe and Emilio): Final event report received. See box at end of minutes.

BARONIAL ANNIVERSARY (Isabel Maria): Report to come.

CANTERBURY TALES (Elise): No further information received regarding event proposed for 14 May.

MONGOL EVENT (Geoffrey): Event to be held over Show Weekend (11-13 November), with possible site being Omaka Scout Camp pending post-earthquake site repairs. Event to feature heavy fighting, archery, and traditional Mongolian wrestling. Possible lunch/dinner plan (thanks to the on-the-spot volunteering of Amalie and Agnes), with breakfasts covered and a cook obtained for a Mongolian themed feast. Projected fees are \$45 for full event, \$10 day-trip, \$25 feast only, and \$25 camping only. Teaser ad campaign

to start soon. Bid moved by Agnes, and seconded by Amalie.

GAMES DAY (Glenn): Few interested in a games day, but need to find a venue before putting together an official bid. Thinking of chess competitions and a variety of other games such as Backgammon, Go, Mah-Jong, and card games.

YULE (Elisabetta): Nothing further to report this month.

KNOWN WORLD HANDBOOK: Baronial copy ordered through HE Eleanora who is organising an order. Chunegund will pay for order and asked for reimbursement. Moved by Geoffrey, and seconded by Glenn.

CRESCENT FENCE: Emilo asked the council if it would be acceptable to send the Crescent Fence banners up to Darton where the event is being held this year. Council was in agreement.

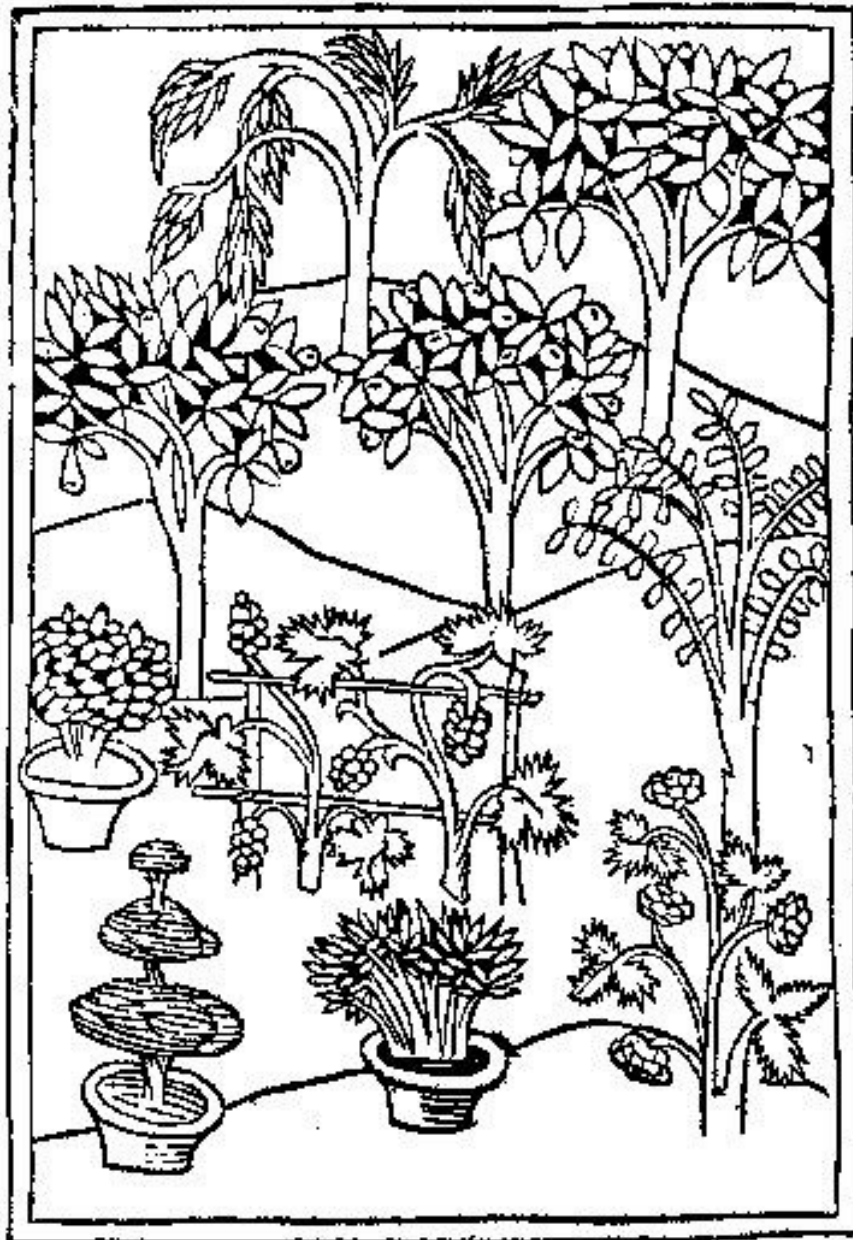

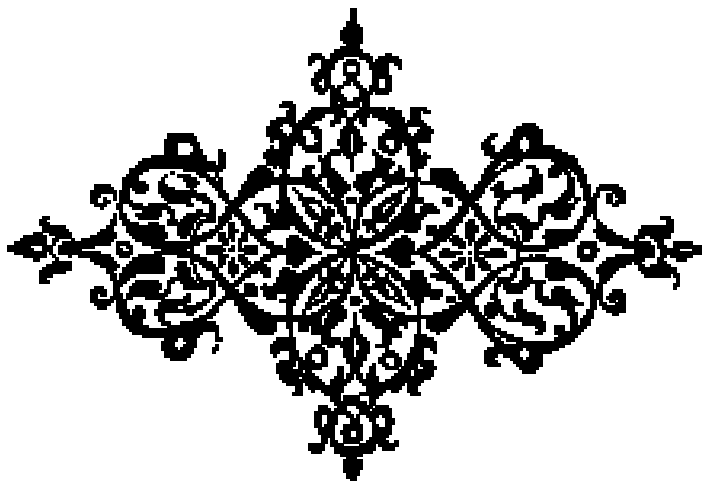
