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

## Their Excellencies Speak

To the populace of Southron Gaard,

This month, we are going to talk about aspects of voluntary work. Before proceeding to the main bit thingy, we would like to thank two people who have done much service for the Barony (and, of course, their lovely ladies who have had put up them stolen away for SCA'dian purposes) in the time they have devoted to our shared hobby.

Lord Lowrens is to step down from his role as Seneschal. We thank him for fine work. We also encourage any amongst you to consider taking up that particular mantle.

We also wish to thank Lord Raffé for the use of Showbiz as a place for storage and holding practices and events. Alas, it will soon literally be no more, and its like in size and availability will be very hard to find.

From time to time, officers, stewards, and people looking after other aspects of our game, such as those wrangling aspects of an event, may come a cropper. Real life may intrude, or they may make an error in calculations regarding the time some work requires. They may realise they do not have the time or resources to carry out a task they volunteered for, or something may simply get forgotten.

Anyone can make such an error. The best thing to do is to admit it as early as possible. This gives other people time to make alternative plans to make up for what has not been done or to find alternatives. It takes considerable courage to admit to a mistake - I think more courage than it takes to enter the lists, even against someone you know will very clearly defeat you. I have seen and heard of it being done several times.

When a volunteer makes such a mistake, and admits it, so that they or others can set to fixing the problem, it is right to respect them for that admission and move on. They are, after all, a volunteer, and we should be grateful that they offered their services and have done what they are able to.

What is more difficult to be happy with is when a volunteer either conceals the mistake/oversight until it is too late to rectify, or worse, tries to blame others for the error or its consequences. To the people affected, this is unfair (to put it mildly) and subsequently makes it less likely that they will want to do further work for the group. We do not have the volunteers to spare, be they cooks or cleaners, stewards, musicians, servers or general helpers. It would be a shame to discourage any who step forward.

Knowing when to admit to a mistake and make an apology is a test of character. It can demonstrate the bravery and chivalry worthy of any peer. Not knowing is unfortunate. Knowing but refusing to do it, and shifting the attention to others, is, well, regrettable.

What is not regrettable is the recent surge in enthusiasm in the Barony. Various practices and workshops have been well attended with some spectacular progress on personal projects. We extend heartfelt thanks to Baron Callum, Lady Isolde and Lady Christine, in particular, for their efforts in recent weeks.

## Seneschal's Comments

In last month's FTT column, I noted that, on average, one of the Barony's offices changes hands about every other month. The office of Seneschal is no different.

Currently, I plan to be stepping down at Baronial Anniversary next year. Therefore, it is coming up to time to be raising the matter of my successor in people's minds.

The process of appointment is thus: a candidate applies to the Kingdom Seneschal, with a copy to the Baron and Baroness to keep them informed. When applications are closed, the Kingdom Seneschal consults as he or she sees fit, and makes the appointment, with the usual two week period for comment from members of the Barony.

I would hope that this appointment will be confirmed by about Canterbury Faire next year. This would give an opportunity for the new Seneschal to understudy for a month or so before formally taking office. When I took office, my predecessor, Oswyn, had his own challenges with having taken up the other major positions in the Barony, and consequently, our handover was less managed than desirable, which in turn made my first few months a bit more challenging. I see no reason to repeat this next time.

As well as the handover period, I will be available to the new Seneschal as deputy/backup for a further several months.

What is entailed in the position of Seneschal? The Officer Job Descriptions document on the Southron Gaard website (at <http://sg.lochac.sca.org/docs/OfficerDescription.s.doc>) lists the basic duties, and I would not quibble with any of these, but there is always the

other stuff as well, that falls under the general heading of "as required".

The "what" of the office is not so much the issue as the "why". Why would you want to become Seneschal? It's certainly not a ceremonial position. There is no function at Court, nor any fancy garb trimmings. It's mostly about stewardship, for all the large and small background things that make the fun and shiny things, the events and other activities, possible and easy. In a nutshell, it is about service, that magic stuff that powers our Society and many, many, others, and other people have written much more about it and better, than I can or will attempt.

So, now is a time to be thinking about this, and, if you want more insight into what is involved, please talk to me. There will be no commitment or expectation implied or taken from any enquiry.

As a final thought, I leave you with the Seneschals' motto: "It's not such an awful job. Really."

# Southron Gaard Council Meeting

Wednesday 14th August 2013

**PRESENT:** Calach (Bevan), Eva (Sarah), Darayavaush (Damon), Isolde (Christine), Callum (Bob), Lucia (Betty), Lowrens (Scott), Quentin (Melina)

**APOLOGIES:** Oswyn (Carl), Isabel Maria (Miriam), Mahasti (Agate), Elena (Niamh)

**MEETING OPENED:** 7:35pm

**PREVIOUS MINUTES:** No discussion. Carried and accepted.

## **OFFICER REPORTS:**

**B&B** (Oswyn and Isabel Maria): A very quiet month. Attended a Make Cafe A&S evening. Correspondence with the Seneschal re vacant offices and applicants: also regarding the storage of Baronial property (mostly incoming from the Seneschal). Discussions with members of the populace re access to information regarding Baronial accounts and Courts. Correspondence received from HE Katherine re images of comets to be drawn upon for the coming Canterbury Faire. Isabel Maria attended the archery competition, and took a couple of pictures for FITT.

**SENESCHAL** (Lowrens): Correspondence with B&B and Kingdom officers about officer vacancies and appointments, with B&B and Sigurd and others re Baronial trailer, with Briford Trailers re trailer inspection, with Richard and others re signing up a storage container, with Raffe re moving remaining Baronial kit from Showbiz site, with Raffe re the demo at Antique Arms, with Antonia and Reeve re credit card and other CF payment options, with SCANZ committee re property insurance, with Reeve and Richard about sundry expense claims.

No detectable cultural activity.

**REEVE** (Mahasti): There was much reeving though mostly in preparation and I am working on

that (quarterly report) form that Mýrún wants. Financial Summary:

Income for July \$1491.58

Expenses \$364.37

Net gain \$1127.21

Total (cash) assets at 13 August: \$27,900.89, liabilities \$463.00, hence net worth \$27,437.89.

**HERALD** (Lucia): Quarterly report sent to Kingdom. Lady Mýrún has submitted name and device registrations for a couple of people from Dunedin (and kindly sent me a copy for the files), and Baron Callum ran a banner workshop which went very well.

**ARTS AND SCIENCES** (Isolde): A bit quiet, activity-wise, with a visit to the Make Cafe during the past month, to carry on with projects.

Had correspondence with Lady Christine, who is returning to Christchurch on Saturday 24<sup>th</sup> August, where we will meet at Sir Callum's school premises to have two days of sewing and making. Plans for people to join in dinner out afterwards. Correspondence with Lady Elisabetta and Lord Raffe re A & S collegium, pencilled in for the later part of this year. No firm dates/progress as yet. Correspondence with two Kingdom Laurels re participating in A & S teaching for our barony.

**CHRONICLER** (Eva): Attended the Yule Archery Tourney, shot and enjoyed myself. Attended Sir Callum's workshop day, mostly finished my banner I decided to create. Got the FITT out on time, and had correspondence with the B&B, the Seneschal, Lord Calach and Lord Darayavaush.

**WEBWRIGHT** (Vacant): This office is currently vacant. There is an ad in FITT. Waiting for applications...

**CHATELAINE** (Quentin): A quiet month. Looking to move most garb to the storage container. As long as garb is enclosed, it should be fine.

**QUARTERMASTER** (Vacant): This office is currently vacant. Have signed up a storage container at Belfast for six months (to 1 Feb 2014). On 3 August, Raffé, Callum, Calach and Lowrens moved remaining kit from Showbiz to the container. Lowrens currently holds the access card and padlock keys to the container. The trailer is squatting at Lowrens' place, and it would be nice to have it somewhere else. Advert for new QM is currently running in FTT.

**CONSTABLE** (Bjorn): Nothing to report.

**MARSHALL** (Callum): Martial little activity. Ran a banner workshop, and plan to use the Linwood Intermediate School for a Collegium. Did a light-weight demo at Ilam Primary School.

**CAPTAIN OF ARCHERS** (Darayavaush): Not a lot happened this last month. The weather was not conclusive to much archery. I did attend and run the Yule archery tourney, and Callum's stuff day. Correspondence with the Chronicler, and other captains via the archers list discussing archers rankings; also correspondence with Tony Simpson (Principal of Phillipstown School) for the use of their field for archery practice, and have the green light. Archery in Dunedin moves slowly as their appointed captain does not have the archery equipment - I'm not sure where it is; it seems to have been scattered amongst various peoples.

**CAPTAIN OF RAPIER** (Elena): Captain of Rapier has been inundated with Real-life (tm) due to injury, work stress, house flooding (and an enforced move out for 5 weeks living out of a suitcase) so very little to report.

Due to a lack of indoor venues, and being midwinter, Sunday practices have been sporadic at best due to weather. However one of our number has been doing some work on Cappel Ferro and has the interest of several other participants weather permitting.

As the weather warms we will be looking to work on Authorisations and MIT training.

There have been no tournaments held in the last quarter.

**CHIRURGEON** (Kotek): No report received.

## **EVENT REPORTS:**

### **Recent Events:**

**Midwinter Encampment:** Post event report received from Mýrún. Had 8 adults/2 children, 9 at the feast. The Baron attended but held no court. The site is a good one. Well stocked kitchen with two good ovens; well placed bunk rooms. Expenses \$476, income \$367, hence net loss \$109, due to lower attendance than budget.

**Antique Arms Demo:** Lots of interest in the SCA stand, from young to 80 years. Came runner-up in the "best display" prize. Good interest from the attendees in the fighting displays, and more contacts from the (overblown) Press report. Helpers were John, Raffé, Calach, Callum, Gregory.

### **Upcoming Events:**

Rumours of a collegium/workshop event in September will actually be the weekend of 24 August at Linwood Intermediate School.

We have an invitation to attend the Ellesmere A&P Show in October. Lowrens to gauge interest and reply.

Quentin expects to present Golden Flight bid at September's Council.

Only a feast cook remains to be found; other helpers are arranged.

## **GENERAL BUSINESS:**

**Storage update:** A container in Belfast is hired for 6 months to 1<sup>st</sup> Feb 2014. The stuff from the Showbiz lock up has been moved there. The trailer is currently at the Seneschal's place – would be nice to move it somewhere else.

**Update on insurance:** Using information to hand, SG could easily list about \$15k replacement costs for the large items that we own. Library replacement not yet costed. Lowrens to pass this number back to SCANZ committee for consideration. No news what Ildhafn or Darton are doing re this.

**Ranking of Archers:** Darayavaush has been part of discussion on the Archers list about ranking methods within local groups.

Politarochopolis using IKAC score as a basis, other groups use Royal Round scores. He proposed a system of tokens such as described at <http://sca.uwaterloo.ca/DistantShore/archery.htm>, based on at least three scores a year to qualify.

Darayavaush to send this proposal to the B&B for consideration.

## Quartermaster Wanted

**VACANCY - WE NEED A NEW QUARTERMASTER!!!!**

Now that Lord Angus has served his term, and more, this office of the Barony stands empty.

The duties of the Quartermaster are:

- \* To manage the storage and to keep track of Baronial equipment,
- \* To ensure clean and secure storage of the Baronial equipment,
- \* Communicate with event stewards/cooks regarding required equipment for events, and arrange pick up/drop off,
- \* To maintain the Baronial Inventory, and check off returned equipment,
- \* Report to Council regarding status of equipment, including loss, damage, replacement or new equipment required.

The quartermaster is a deputy to the Seneschal and reports to him/her as well as the Council.

The amount of Baronial gear is currently beyond the scope of most of us being able to provide our own storage space (about a single-car garage space). At present, the Barony has access to free lockable storage in central Christchurch, thanks to connections at Showbiz.

Because of other things going on in central Christchurch, Showbiz have to move out later this year, and therefore so do we. We are resigned to having to pay for commercial storage for a while until we find a new home for our stuff.

This is all by way of saying that you don't personally have to provide storage to be the QM - it's about keeping tabs on what we have and who needs it, and when.
