Sandra (Aveline) - heralding at Baronial Anniversary. Angela (Anna) & Richard (Richard) - regarding SCANZ insurance discussion. Sarah (Eva) & Richard (Richard) - regarding FTT. Projects: SG awards - researching what other Baronies do in wake of comments from TRMs, with a view to re-aligning expectations for awards or need for additional awards. Tour d'Or insta-scrolls while we wait for tokens. Tokens for Court

Main money in for BA, Main money out for CF site fees, marquee, meal reimbursements. Further signatures are required for changeover of login/signators

HERALD (Aveline): Last month saw 2 successful device and one name registration for members of our populace. Several registrations are being prepared, some with the assistance of other members of the college of heralds, and 1 name and device registration was sent to Rocket Herald. Have sent a missive to Their Excellencies regarding Baronial Anniversary, have not as yet heard back. Contact with Sir Tyco and THL Ginevra around heralding tasks at BA.

ARTS AND SCIENCES (Agnes): Had 2 classes in the past month, one for planning the coming year's projects, one making some Italian tableware. The next class will be a continuation of same.

Class suggestions and call for tutors published on the Facebook page, E-mailed list and sent to FTT for possible inclusion.

CHRONICLER (Eva): FTT is out but not announced.

Plans to seek a replacement for September

WEBWRIGHT (Ginevra): Monitored mailing lists and Facebook, updated addresses to reflect officer/ steward changeovers, updated some webpages.

CHATELAINE (Philippe): Returned to Redwood Scout Hall in the last month, as my weekends are now available again. I ran informal classes the last few weeks on basic pellwork for two young boys, age 11, Cullen and Lucas. Their parents have been very supportive. Requested boffers to be brought to the next meeting by Lord Raffé. Hire garb is being relocated to 24 Meadowville Avenue, Spreydon, from 1 Kiln Place, Kaiapoi.

QUARTERMASTER (Raffé): Cannot add due to not receiving.

CONSTABLE (Vacant): No report. Raffé is going to apply.

MARSHAL (Elena):

Rapier: Last 3 weekends have had between 5-9 attendees at practice, as meeting and follow on practices have occurred. KRM has authorised the appointment of Lord James of Southron Gaard as new Captain, pending the 2 week commentary period.

Heavy: Practices continue well. Communicated with Kingdom Earl Marshall as to more detailed report on the Injury to his Majesty's hand at Canterbury Faire. Received report from Sir Tycho who was present at the time, although details were not readily discussed as to what actually occurred. To forward these details on to KEM this week.

Archery: IKAC took place in the last month. Big push on from current Baronial Champion to get a large number of competitors at this year's Baronial Anniversary.

CHIRURGEON (Kotek): No report. No applications yet.

Canterbury Faire (Richard): Financial report mostly complete. Still chasing up a few last payments.

Upcoming Events:

Baronial Anniversary: 65 Adults and 9 children booked so far. A lot of people have commented asking for more information. Need to look at why.

Beating the Bounds (Wildmoor): This weekend assuming the weather is fine.

Fimbulwinter: No further news. Currently planned for late August.

Yule: No further news.

Children's event/picnic: Thoughts of a possible event. Garbed. 2nd or 3rd weekend of April at fighters/archery practice.

Labour Weekend (Golden Flight?): Proposal expected from Darius

Canterbury Faire 2016: A lot of budget tweaking has had to be done. Mostly relating to shuttles, marquee and trailer. As a result event fees are likely to be up \$20. The current budget is based on this year's numbers and is conservative. Isabel Maria is to do another budget and review the costs. This is to be sent to the financial committee before it is forwarded to the kingdom.

Tapestry Tour: A motion was made to pay a total of \$500 for the tour with the understanding that an event bid and outline be provided soon. Further funding requests to be accompanied by fundraising plan. Motioned by Richard, seconded by Darius. Unanimously passed.

GENERAL BUSINESS:

Fealty Chains: The current fealty chains are coming apart. Replacing the chains would cost approximately AU\$80 each through Mistress Rowan. A motion to allocate NZ\$200 was put forward by Isabel Maria, seconded by Eva. Isabel Maria abstained, otherwise unanimous.

Fencing Masks: A suggestion to purchase 3 new fencing masks (2 mediums, 1 large) from darkwood armoury for use as loaner gear. Approximate cost of US\$80 each and less than US\$60 in shipping. A motion to purchase these was put forward by James, seconded by Richard. Unanimously passed.

B&B (Oswyn and Isabel Maria): Correspondence: Aveline & Richard - re deputy (book) herald queries & policy interpretation, Aveline & Chunegunde - re BA heralding, Aveline - re Kingdom award tokens, Eva - re FTT column & announcements, Les Belles Vilaines - re Noblesse de Robe workshop/performance, Ronan - re A&S & Archery Championships, Numerous - re Letters of Intent, Richard - re Wildmoor incipient status. Attended Baronial Anniversary (both Oswyn and Isabel Maria) and Sunday Practices - as available to attend.

SENESCHAL (Richard): Discussion re Wildmoor status. B & B and I agreed that Wildmoor has met the requirements agreed 2 years ago for SG to sponsor their advancement to official status. Richard to contact Kingdom and Wildmoor re next steps. Email from storage facility re alarm activation. Was raised after entry to container without gate swipe. Assume it was Raffé.

REEVE (James): No report.

HERALD (Aveline): Lots of correspondence. I have done some following up with several heralds who last month agreed to assist with the backlog of submissions after Faire. Corresponded with Lord Darius and THL Richard, and also Crux re a hiatus in submission processing while a new Rocket Herald was set up. Have talked to 1 local

member regarding possible name and device registration.

Lord Thorald has volunteered to be the Deputy Book Herald, and after some correspondence with his Excellency and THL Richard I have accepted his application.

Have boxes and bags of associated gear. Part of this comprised of the heraldic books used by the book herald as a resource, which I would like to send to Thorald for his use. Stash of old newsletters, including Pegasus, Crown Prints (Caid), FTT's and some from the SG College. Lady Eva, has volunteered to have the FTT's and college newsletters scanned. These have been posted to her so she may begin that task. I have emailed the Pegasus editor to see if they have copies of what is in the box, I may need to resend that email as I've not heard back. I'm looking to find appropriate homes for these newsletters as they don't rightly belong with the heraldic gear.

Also with the gear was a folder of old paper copies of SG heraldic registrations. The Lochac college of heralds has had their copies scanned, and these are only held electronically now. I would like to do the same with these copies, namely scan them (I have a suitable scanner) and store them on CD and/or flash drive. When this task is completed I would arrange for the secure destruction of those paper documents. Discussed and suggested storing these documents on Dropbox.

ARTS AND SCIENCES (Agnes): Classes on painted tableware. Need ones on garb – looking for teachers. Attended BA. Appointed deputy in Wildmoor (Josh).

CHRONICLER (Eva): Ftt to be out shortly, otherwise quiet. Plans to seek a replacement for September

WEBWRIGHT (Ginevra): Normal mailing list activity. Minor tweaks to website. Discussion with people re change to Drupal to allow shared content management.

CHATELAINE (Philippe): No Demo activity this month. Missed the Armageddon event this year, will plan to make a more effective demo schedule for next year's event. The next Demo will be the Arms and Militaria Show at Riccarton Racecourse, in July (date TBA). Attended Baronial Anniversary and took hire garb, however only one person claimed their booking, and only stayed a few hours. I stepped up as Captain of the Baronial Guard. This should not adversely impact my ability to fulfil the Office of Hospitaller. More hire garb has been relocated to Meadowville Avenue, from Kaiapoi. Hire garb has been laundered and checked for repairs. I would like to request a grant from the Council, for approximately \$20.00 to \$30.00 for buttons, ribbon and thread to make necessary hire garb repairs. I will provide receipts for said items. (Seneschal noted that standing financial policy allows officers to spend up to \$50 per annum on supplies for office without council approval, therefore no vote required. Seneschal to advise Philippe to go ahead).

QUARTERMASTER (Raffe): Cannot add due to not receiving.

CONSTABLE (Vacant): Vacant.

MARSHAL (Elena): Attended BA. Correspondence with Tycho re MIC for BA. Assisted with rapier marshalling. Heavy champion: Sir Philippe. 5-8 fighters attending practice regularly. Received report from Wildmoor – training continuing, no breakages. Archery: Archery championship at BA won by THL Richard.
