## Seneschal's Comments

Hello everyone,

First, congratulations and thanks to Glenn for running his first event. Stewards are in short supply, and the more the better!

Moving on to a minor point of etiquette and infelicities of expression. A short while ago, a lady's name came up in conversation; the person I was speaking to, not knowing them, asked 'Who's partner is she?'

The question is perfectly reasonable but it could be misinterpreted and/or not taken well by some. It might be better to ask, 'Who is she?' rather than ask who she is in terms of her partner. No one ought to or needs to be defined by their partner. Even if it's not the intent, the question makes it sound as

if the person asking it does define people that way.

Also, if the question is asked by a fighter, it might be interpreted as: 'Who is the partner/are they a fighter?' which suggests the asking person might think whether they are a fighter or not is important. It may be to fighters, but may not be to non-fighters. Heavy fighting is central to the SCA; Crown is a heavy tournament. But plenty of active contributing members don't do heavy.

Fighters may know mostly fighters, and not know artisans. Artisans may know mostly artisans, and not know fighters. It is natural that we might want to define others by their relation to or own interests, or at least find out whether they are involved in it. This is a

reminder that the SCA is bigger than any of us or individual social groups or pastimes. It would be a good thing if we all got to know people outside our own spheres of interest - if we got know them for what they find interesting. We might even come to appreciate their hobbies.

This is a very small matter. But it always helps to make a good first impression on someone. And 'who's partner is she?' may not be the best first question to ask someone, or of someone.

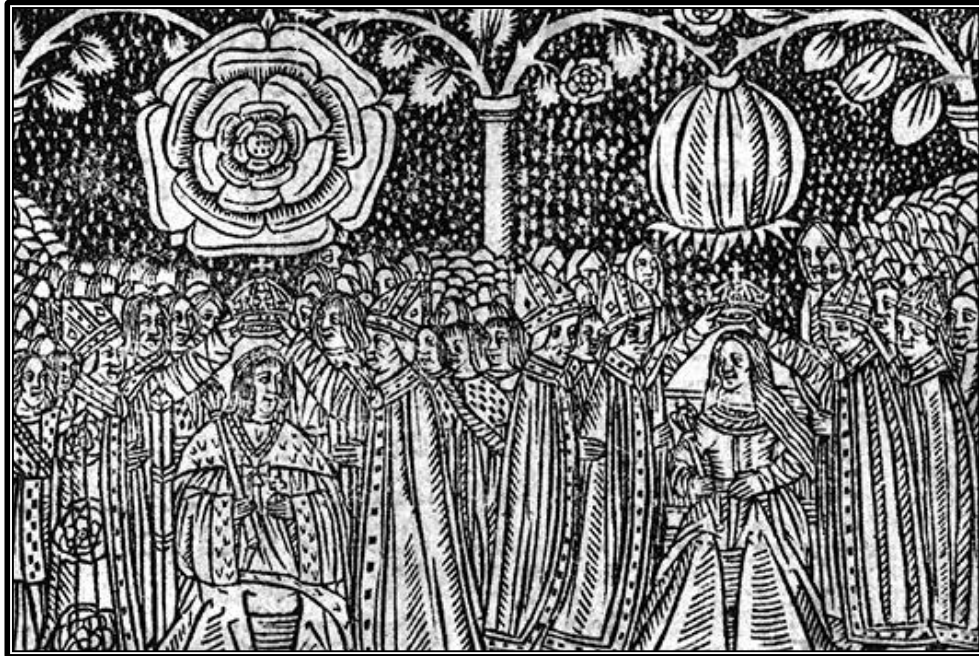

**25 September 2011 to 09 October 2011** - Discussion between Candidates and Populace

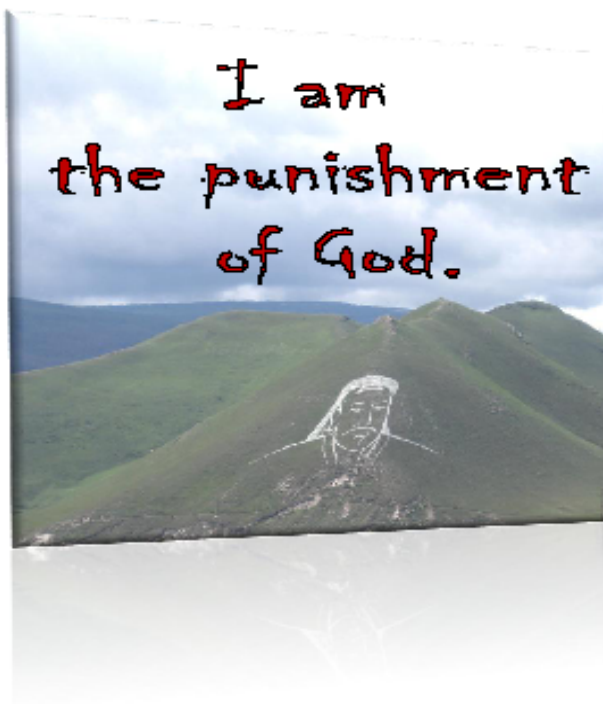
**09 October 2011 to 23 October 2011** - Consultation Period and Poll

Tuesday 23rd August 2011

**MEETING OPENED:** 7.40 pm

**JULY MINUTES:** Moved to accept minutes – Chunegund, Seconded – Lucia. Accepted

## **OFFICER REPORTS:**

**SENESCHAL** (Oswyn): Correspondence with Vicar, Kingdom Seneschal, and officers regarding whether officer reports should be sent to the Vicar, and whether the vicar needs to send a report to the Seneschal. Correspondence with Lords Richard, Raffie and Ratbod, and the Financial Committee, regarding the prospective CF event budget. Correspondence with Lord Ratbod concerning the purpose of the financial committee, Council, and campsite locations for CF 12. Contact with HE Katherine Kerr and a representative for the Ellesmere A and P show.

**HEAVY MARSHAL** (Callum): Nothing to report.

**CHRONICLER** (Elisabetta): August issue loaded to website and sent to subscribers on 1 August. Correspondence with Vicar, Seneschal, contributors regarding content. Mýrún regarding handing over files and reins of power. Mýrún will edit the September issue with my oversight and from then on FITT will be all hers and this will be the last report from me!! Have enjoyed my time as Chronicler!

**RAPIER**            **MARSHALL:**            Office vacant. General observation of ‘not much by way of practices’.

**LISTS:** Office vacant.

**WEBWRIGHT** (Eleanora): Updated the regnum and changed email redirection as required. Updated the newcomers’ page from the chatelaine’s instructions including the SCA brochure and fabric-shopping document. Updated the Baronial Champions information on the traditions page; I am about to email the herald and ask him to check the other information on that page which includes baronial awards. Added information regarding the Baronial changeover process, role of the vicar etc. A few small changes to the Populace page. Added and edited event information in our Google calendar. Made some minor changes to the style sheets and some coding to start updating the coding used e.g. using styles rather than deprecated html attributes for layout etc. Spoken with Vicar and Ildhafn webwright about using the Ildhafn forum or something similar as a discussion forum for the SG’s up and owing B and B poll. Also queried Council about a policy regarding the entries of people who no longer play being up on the populace page.

**ARTS & SCIENCEES** (Amalie): Some informal making of award cords has been taking place, and Amalie has been putting together Mouse Guard pouch kits, which should be ready to distribute soon. The archers have been holding armouring classes regularly. A Baronial Games Faire provided entertainment for seven people this weekend. Next following weekend is the Fimbulwinter camping event in St. Kessog, where a bunch of A&S is planned.



**VICAR** (Amalie): Attended the Games Day. Correspondence with the Baronial Seneschal, Crown and Kingdom Seneschal.

**HERALD** (Maximilian): Received 1 submission (completed, herald's copy), 2 submissions to finish off (1 resend to Rocket, 1 finalize with applicant). Purchased pens so can do herald work. Will be billing Barony for ~\$20 (2 sets of Crayola markers, already purchased). No intention to attend Games Day event.

**CAPTAIN OF ARCHERS** (Geoffrey): Archery has been cancelled twice due to snow, once due to general poor weather. The Yule Arrow shoot was organised by Lady Ellen, and attended by 8 archers, and a few others. It was won by Lady Yngvildr. Armour workshops have been continuing, and are now being held every other Sunday. After the "In Service to the Dream" viewing, I've been asked if the Baronial library has a copy that can be loaned to St Kessog. If possible Mýrún will collect it next time she's up here, and return it then.

**CONSTABLE** (Agnes): Nothing to report.

**CHATELAINE** (Chunegund): Attended games date. Heard from one newcomer, who attended games event with sons and plans to come along again to outdoor events. Provided hire garb to two people. Garb labelling continues. Experimenting with database for garb – currently photographing each item. Updated info on newcomers webpage and forwarded to webwright.

Written report submitted after Council.

**QUARTERMASTER** (Angus): No report.

**REEVE** (Richard): After carefully printing the report, I left it on the printer. Approx \$800.00 income last month therefore balances still healthy and allow us to continue business as usual.

Presented a draft budget for CF 12 to the Seneschal for use for a discussion of the event budget proposed by Lords Ratbod and Raffe.

### **EVENT REPORTS:**

**GAMES DAY** (Glen, 20/08/2011): 10 people at attended (included 1 comped child). CCC provided incorrect details for hall hire. Did not hold formal courts, may have started Solitaire additions. Two new trophies for the games in the Barony – one for teams and one for solos. Income: \$78. Expenses: \$65.65 for hall, \$4 for cleaning product. After Kingdom and SCANZ levies, the event made a \$5.65 loss. Council approved finances. Budget available on request.

**GOLDEN FLIGHT – MONGOL HORDE** (Geoffrey, 18-20/11/2011): Changed site due to inadequacies with planned venue. New site (Rimu Park) less expensive so event fees reduced. 2½ day event – opens Friday afternoon and closes 4pm Sunday. Accept changes to event: Moved Elena, seconded Oswyn, accepted.

**CANTERBURY FAIRE** (Raffe & Rat, 28/01-5/02/2012): Considerable discussion on finances – Reeve querying line items, e.g. advertising costs, feast ticket price increases/reduction in tickets vs. alternate feast, increases in tent hire costs etc. Lord Ratbod not keen to discuss line items, wanting just to get budget approved so progress can be made on booking forms and advertising. Suggested that maybe Council should run CF.

Advertising budget of \$300 queried – only \$90 needed for Pegasus. Ratbod explained the other \$210 to be used for advertising to students on UC campus. Council queried whether this was an effective use of baronial money, given that the UCMRS could already publicise CF for us, and students interested in something like CF are likely to already be involved in medieval things via the UCMRS. Council agreed to ok the extra this CF, and requested a change to the booking forms to ask how people found out about CF to ascertain the effect/efficacy of the advertising. If it is not

found to have made a difference to attendance, the extra funding will not be approved next year.

Feast price and ticket maximum – only 104 seats this year, at \$25 a head. Various people expressed concern that the price was high – but there have been other events with high feast prices. The lower number of seats was queried. Lord Ratbod stated the cooks they are using, headed by Isabel Winter, want to do something special with the hall, and it will only fit 104.

(Seneschal's addendum - Lord Raffe stated last Council that Lord Ratbod was also talking to another cook in Southron Gaard who had expressed interest in cooking the CF feast. Ratbod stated he was unaware of this).

Other issues, e.g. hireage of three site tents for purposes unknown to Ratbod, not resolved. Council required that the reason for their hire be discovered.

Council also expressed concern that CF remains financially within reach of our less well-off local members. Visiting Australians are likely to be able to deal with price rises, but some of our locals may not be. While CF showcases the barony to overseas visitors, it should still be accessible to the locals.

To re-visit and assess changes to feast after the event. Accept changes to budget: moved: Agnes, seconded: Glen, accepted. Much of 2011 website still archived – needs to be updated. Bookings to open as soon as Peter can get it going.

Budget available on request.

**Customary Campsites:** Rat indicated he wants to move the Amberherthe encampment off the main field to make room for combat archers and a trebuchet in war scenarios 'to shoot into that corner'. Ratbod said he'd like to 'dump the decision on Council' and was happy for Council to arrange a general meeting concerning campsite locations. When asked by Robyn if he still wished the outcome of this meeting to be a decision to make Amberherthe shift, he said 'yes'. Much discussion about customary camp sites, more efficient use of current areas, the use of roads/walkway, restraints on "lateral spread" and the possibilities for growth in numbers of campers. A meeting, with representatives from each customary campsite, to review issues, to be held within 6 weeks. Rat to email the household contacts.

Oswyn asked whether children's use of the swing behind Amberherthe would have to be suspended during war and shooting scenarios, and Ratbod said yes.

Oswyn also said it is important that both Rat and Raffe need to be aware of what the other is doing, and on the same page. Also, people need to know that the stewarding team are in agreement over things any of them ask people to do, particularly if they may cause considerable inconvenience. When Raffe wrote to Miriam regarding Amberherthe's campsite, he said it was fine as it was, and did not need to be shifted.

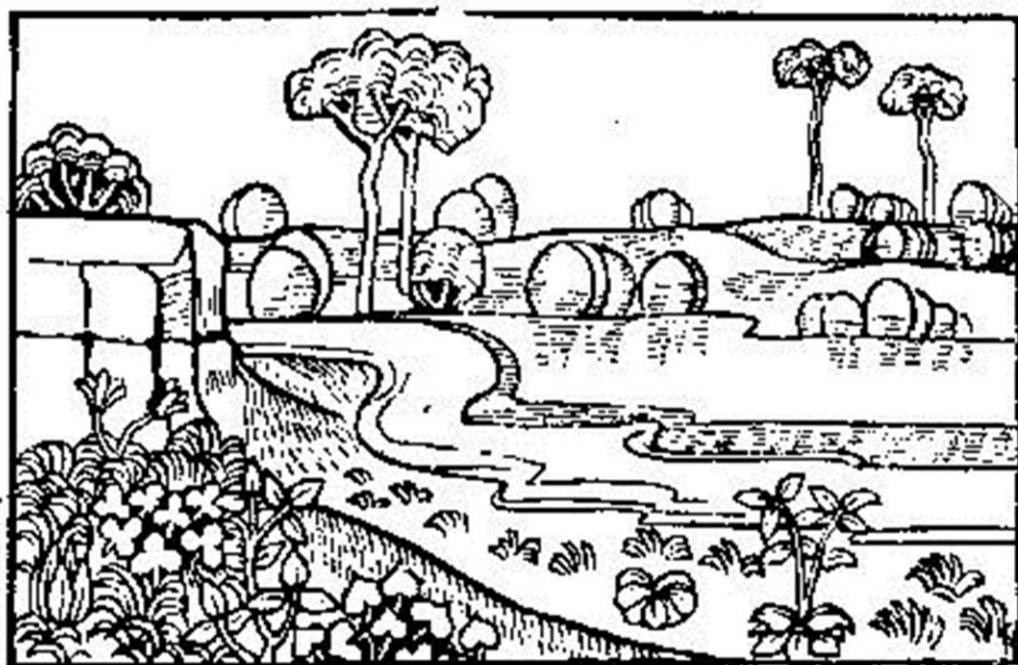

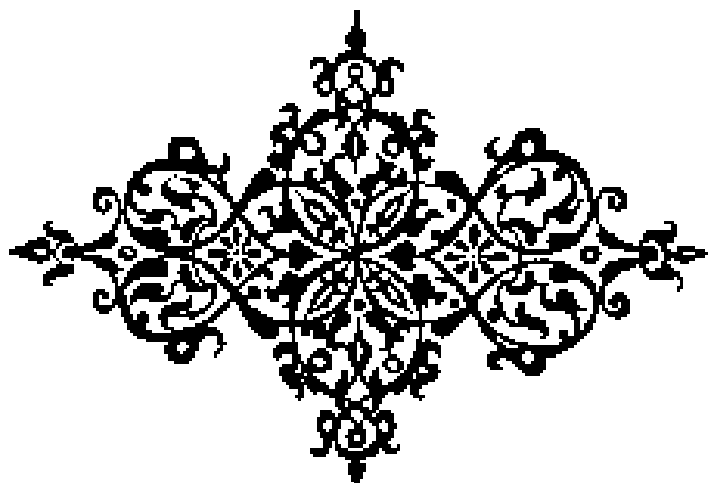
